The history of Romanian rowing began in the nineteenth century, in 1864, when a group of young students from Timisoara, returned from abroad Universities, set up for their pleasure "Societatea de Luntrisoare" (The Society of Small Boats).

In 1925, the Nautical Sports Commission of Romania was established in Arad. It filed in 1927 the application for affiliation to the International Rowing Federation (FISA). The Congress of 19 August 1927 approved the affiliation of the Federation of Sports Societies of Romania as an extraordinary member of FISA.

The first Romanian participation in an international official competition is marked in 1932 at the European Championship in Belgrade, and later in 1933 at the European Championship in Budapest, Romania was represented in open category by M2- and for masters by M4+.

First participation to Olympic Games for Romanian rowers was Helsinky 1952 in M8+.

The first international gold medal was won by the Romanian rowers in 1955 in Ghent at the European Championship by M4- and for women the first gold medal was won by W4+ in Grunau 1962 at European Rowing Championships.

At the World Championships, the first gold medal is won in 1970 at St.Catharines in the M2+, and women won first gold medal in W2- at the World Championship in 1974 in Lucerna.

The first Olympic gold medal was won in 1980 Moscow, by Sanda Toma in W1x, and in Los Angeles 1984, the pair won the first gold medal for men's category.
